The Rural Payments Agency would like to thank you for the support you have given to managing and protecting the countryside through Environmental or Countryside Stewardship.

We hope that you will consider applying for Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier this year.

Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier is different from Environmental Stewardship, some elements are competitively scored or you can enter a "Wildlife Offer" which are simpler to apply for and non-competitive. These 4 Offers consist of an expanded range of land management options in 2020 designed for either arable, lowland grazing, mixed farming or upland farms.

Applications for Mid Tier, including the Wildlife Offers, are now open and close on 31 July 2020. Successful applications will start on 1 January 2021.

If you are thinking of applying for Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier this year, you may be interested in a remote one-to-one session. The session will review the recent changes to the scheme, options to apply for and how to complete and submit your application.

Due to Covid-19 these sessions will be run remotely. To get the most out of a one-to-one session, it is advisable to have access to a computer with internet capabilities. Your one-to-one session will last up to 1hr 30mins (via an online teleconference facility that you will be invited to join via email) with an experienced adviser who will advise on the most suitable Mid Tier options for your farm and how to fill out your application. It is essential that you have an idea of what you want to achieve with your application prior to your session.

Booking is essential for an online one-to-one as places are limited.
